Ofsted have unfortunately, not upheld our complaints and the comments have remained in the report. Our children are respectful, kind and have a very good understanding about diversity and difference. They are continually learning about other religions and are tolerant and respectful to all. This is sadly not reflected in the report. We are immensely proud of all of our children and we want to reassure you that we are passionate about preparing them for multi-cultural Britain and life in a diverse and modern society.

The report leaves us with only two recommendations, one of which we are disputing. Therefore, we are proud to say that the children at Cheadle Catholic Infant School receive an excellent education and a great start to their school life.

Your support has been overwhelming and the results on parent view confirm your appreciation of all that we do. This means more to us than any Ofsted Report.
