The Month of May

May is the month dedicated to Mary, Mother of God.

During May, each class teacher will send home a prayer bag containing "The Travelling Rosary" with a different child each day.

Each class has one 'Prayer Bag', therefore we ask that it is returned to school the next day to ensure that as many families as possible have the opportunity to share in this experience during May.



Inside the 'Traveling Rosary' prayer bag, there will be cards with the words of the 'Our Father', 'Hail Mary' and 'Glory Be', a tea light and a set of children's wooden rosary beads.

- Light the candle and begin by holding the crucifix, making the sign of the cross.
- On the single bead, pray the 'Our Father'.
- On the set of 10 beads, pray the 'Hail Mary" 10 times.
- Finish by praying the 'Glory Be' and then make the sign of the cross.

We hope you find this a lovely opportunity during the liturgical year to reflect and pray with your children The travelling Rosary will be sent home on Tuesday.

Sport's Mornings:

Weather permitting we will be welcoming parents into the school grounds on the following dates for our Sport's Mornings:

- Wednesday 8th May 9.30am Reception
- Friday 10th May 9.30am Nursery 2
- Monday 20th May 9.30am: Nursery 1 & Nursery children from RN3 Sport's Morning

The events will take place at the back of the school on the field.

We will ask parents to stand on the Mile path to watch.

The children will need to come into school wearing their PE kit including velcro trainers. They will also need a sun hat or cap and a water bottle. If the sun is shining we also ask that sun cream is applied before the children come to school.

We ask that all parents stay in the designated parent area on the path and DO NOT come over to the children whilst they are waiting for their race. We have up to 80 children to supervise and we need to know where they are and who they are with at all times.

If you take photographs or videos please remember that NO images should be put on social media.

We do give stickers to the children for first, second and third in the races and we also ensure that all children receive a sticker for taking part.

Hopefully the sun will shine and we will all have a wonderful morning!

School Uniform Reminder:

A message from Stockport Education Welfare Officers:

Term time holidays

When children miss school for term time holidays not only do they miss out on important learning but they often take time to settle back into their learning routines.

The government is strengthening the rules around Education Penalty Notices. These are fixed penalty fines which can be issued by the Local Authority where 10 or more sessions (5 days) of unauthorised absence take place.

They are most commonly issued to parents when a child misses school for an term time holiday taken without the permission of the school.

The new stronger rules will apply to all offences taking place after August 2024.

- For the <u>first</u> fine issued after the start of the 24-25 school year, the fine will increase to £80 per parent per child if paid within 21 days, or £160 if paid within 28 days.
- If a <u>second</u> fine is then issued to the same parent for the same child within three years of the first fine it
 will be for £160.
- Subsequent offences no further fines can then be issued if two have already been issued to the same parent for the same child within the previous three years (starting with the date of the first fine); instead the parent will be prosecuted by the Local Authority in the Magistrates' Court.

It's therefore more important than ever that parents arrange to take family holidays in the school holidays and not in term time.
