Animals

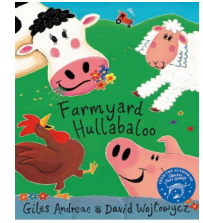
- We will learn about farm animals.

Key Skills

- Continue to recognise set 1 and set 2 sounds in RWI using them to segment and blend words and read simple sentences.
- Begin to spell words by identifying the sounds in them and using the correct letter to represent the sounds.
- Making story maps
- Begin to record marks in Number activities and explain how they found their answer.
- Develop knowledge of number bonds to 10 using a 10s frame and recognise doubles up to 10
- Begin to estimate how many objects they can see and check them by counting.
- Continue to use the part-part whole model to show number bonds up to 10.
