

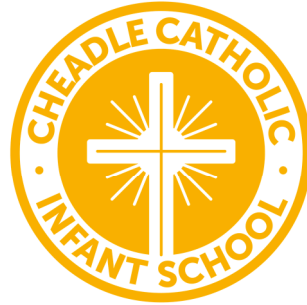
OUR INTENT
