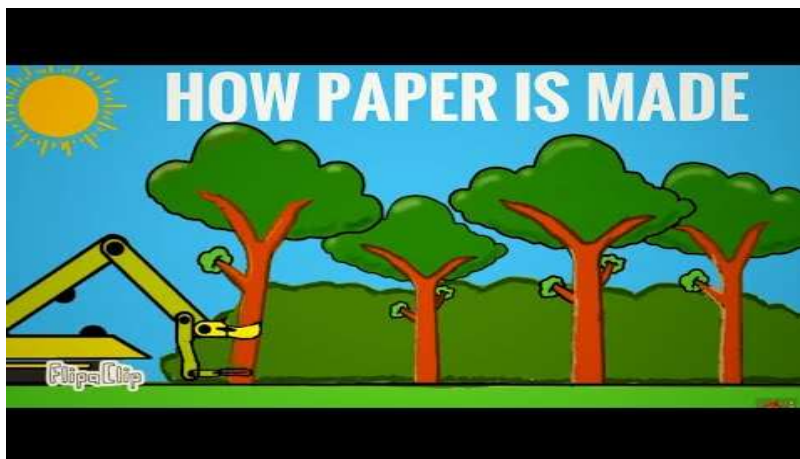
Nursery

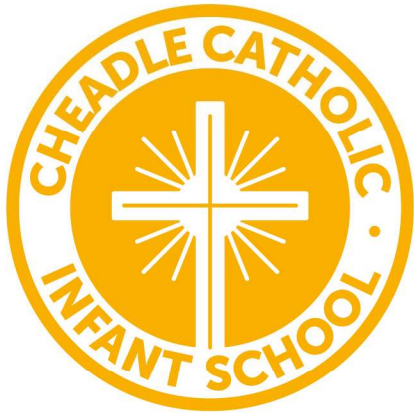

Year One

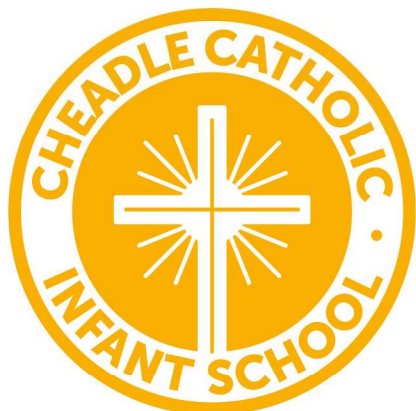
Our year one Eco Warriors went on a litter pick this week around our school grounds. They were delighted that there was very little litter to collect but had lots of fun mastering the litter pickers!

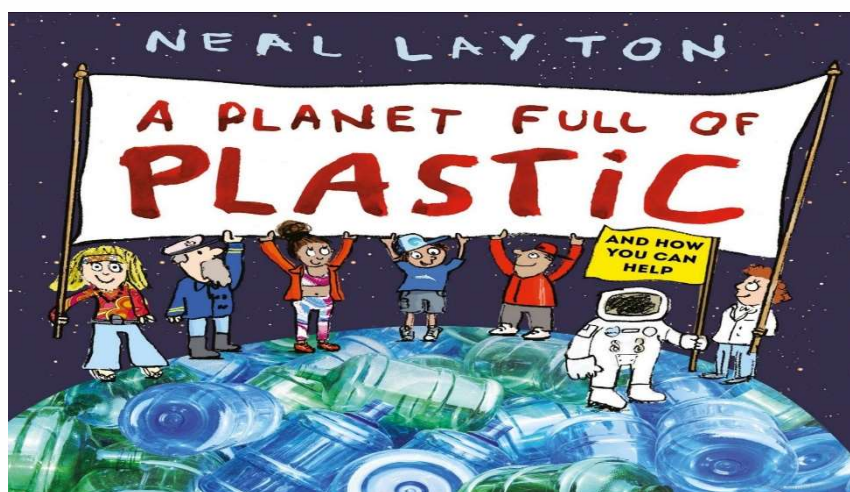

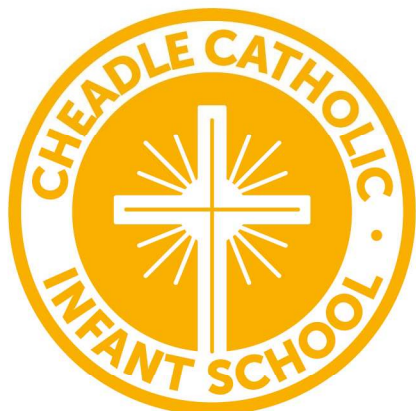
