At Cheadle Catholic Infant School, we follow the statutory exclusion guidance issued by the Department for Education (DfE) when making decisions regarding exclusion from school and carrying out the exclusion process.

The current version of the DfE exclusion guidance 'Exclusion from maintained schools, academies and pupil referral units in England: Statutory guidance for those with legal responsibilities in relation to exclusion' can be found on the school exclusion page of the Gov.uk website: https://www.gov.uk/government/publications/school-exclusion

All maintained schools in England must have regard to this guidance when carrying out their functions in relation to exclusions. The phrase 'must have regard', when used in this context, means that everyone involved in the exclusion process at Cheadle Catholic Infant School will follow the sections of statutory guidance unless there is a good reason not to in a particular case, in which case the reason must be justified.

Our overall approach to exclusions at Cheadle Catholic Infant School is set out in the behaviour policy.

This exclusion policy will be reviewed annually and with any published changes to the statutory DfE exclusion guidance.
