Question 1: My child enjoys school

94% of parents who responded agreed or strongly agreed.

We are really pleased that your children enjoy coming to school and you can see this every day in the way they approach their learning.

Question 2: I am happy with the Catholic teaching, values & attitudes that the school teaches. 98% of parents who responded agreed or strongly agreed.

We are very proud of our core values, mission and ethos. We are proud of our children and the huge progress they make in their journey of faith.

Question 3: My child feels safe & secure in school.

96% of parents who responded agreed or disagreed.

We work very hard to ensure that our children feel safe in school. We teach daily about safeguarding and e-safety. Our Bully Busters and Playground Friends help to make our children feel safe on the playground. Children are taught to always ask for help or tell an adult if they feel unsafe.

Question 4: School informs me about what my child is learning.

86% of parents who responded agreed or strongly agreed.

Communication between home and school is a really important factor for ensuring the best outcomes for your children. We have almost 100% attendance at parent meetings and work hard to make end of year reports informative. Every year group has an information page on our website. This is updated half termly with a knowledge organiser detailing the learning for the coming half term. On Friday each year group also add a weekly information page which outlines learning for the coming week.

Question 5: School involves parents/carers in their child's learning.

98% of parents who responded agreed or strongly agreed.

So far this year we have run a reading workshop and physical development workshop for parents and have maths workshops booked in. We hope that the recent parent consultations and reports have been useful in providing next steps for your child. Our October parents' evenings are 'settling in' meetings and we have

further meetings planned for March. Teachers are also always willing to meet with you to help you if you require further information about your child's learning.

Question 6: School provides a rich & interesting curriculum.

94% of parents who responded agreed or strongly agreed.

90% of parents who responded agreed or strongly agreed.

Our website provides a wealth of information about what we are teaching in school.

Question 8: I am clear about the expectations for learning at home.

84% of parents who responded agreed or strongly agreed

Homework is a valuable part of learning that gives parents the opportunity to engage in their child's learning and support them to improve. I also know, as a parent, that it can be a challenge to fit it in to our busy lives and that children are not always motivated. This is why we try to make it relevant and purposeful but not too arduous to complete and we make sure that it is valued by the teachers so the effort you and your child puts in in rewarded.

Question 9: School provides for my child's individual needs.

86% of parents who responded agreed or strongly agreed

Cheadle Catholic Infant School provides a varied range of themed weeks, activities, visitors and school visits. Again, our teachers work really hard to make learning engaging and fun for the children and we constantly look for opportunities to enhance their learning whilst trying to keep the cost to families as reasonable as possible.

Our response:

1. Music is taught throughout school from Nursery to Year 2.

This year we have enhanced and improved our music offer by introducing children to different genres of music. As well as singing and composing music themselves our children will learn about different composers and artists including Beethoven, Chopin, Elvis Presley and Dolly Parton! We will be exposing children to jazz, classical, blues, country and pop music throughout the year. This half term we are listening to classical music.

Year 2 Maths Mastery Parent Workshop:



It was lovely to welcome so many Year 2 parents into school this week to take part in our Maths Mastery workshop with their children.

To help develop children's fluency we teach a daily 10-15 minutes 'Mastering Number' session separate to the main maths lesson. This programme is a DfE funded initiative run by the National Centre for Excellence in Maths Teaching (NCETM) through the maths hubs, and they have recently developed home learning materials as part of this. At the session parents found out more about their child's learning, played some simple fun games and took away a resource pack to use at home. The children really loved showing their parents/ grandparents their learning
