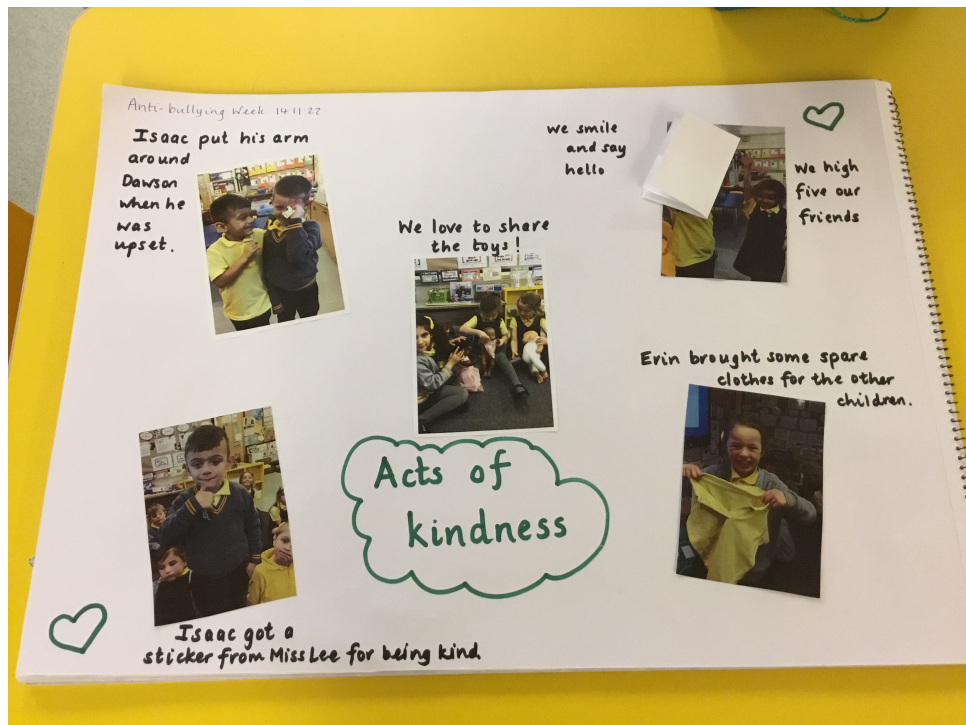
### Monday Assembly:

### **Woodstreet Mission:**

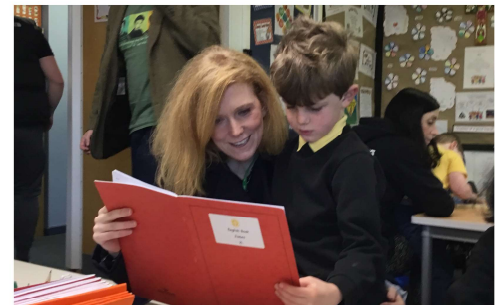
