Nursery & Reception Christmas Productions:

This year our Christmas productions will unfortunately have to be slightly different due to Local Authority covid restrictions.

We are, however, proposing to have a 'scaled down' version of our usual Nursery and Reception Nativities. Each class will perform their Nativity in front of a small audience consisting of a maximum of 2 adults per child. The Nativity will also be filmed and families will have the opportunity to buy a CD form school which can then be shared with other members of the family who won't be able to view the 'live' show.

We are proposing to hold our Nativities on **Monday 13th December**:

Thursday 16th December: N 2: 9.15am

Please note that full time Nursery children will take part in both performances.

We ask that all adults take a lateral flow test before they attend and wear a face mask at all times.

If the Local Authority heighten the restrictions in our area then the shows will have to be cancelled but will they will still be filmed.

Year 1 & 2

Year 1 & 2 children will be filming themselves singing a Christmas Carol. This will then be put onto the school website for families to view.

Year 1 will have the chance to perform for parents at Easter and year 2 at the end of the year.

They have had a great time working as a team to solve problems as well as finding out lots of new facts about rationing and allies. They also looked at some genuine artefacts from World War 2.

Building Fund

As a Catholic school the majority of our income comes from state funding. However, in return for the right to promote the Catholic Faith, 10% of the cost of all building work, repairs and maintenance must be met by the Diocese. At one point, donations through collection at mass were enough to meet this cost, but funding from the `plate' has fallen well short of the bill for many years now.

In 2000 the Shrewsbury Diocese introduced a building fund in order to meet the 10% cost of all works on its Catholic schools with all those parents choosing Catholic education for their children asked to make the voluntary contribution of £15 per child, per year.

Whilst this is a suggested donation, Cheadle Catholic Infant School has to make a payment for each child to the Diocesan fund - regardless of whether parents opt to pay or not.

Last year we had to pay the shortfall from the school budget - money that was much needed for resources, energy costs etc.

I do appreciate that this has been a difficult couple of years for families but I would ask parents to consider why choosing a place at a Catholic school was so important to you and make a donation if you can.

I have attached a leaflet with details of how to pay. Alternatively you may pay using our online Sims payment
(pay360 Education Payments) system.
