Throughout the week we have sent a clear and positive message that bullying is not acceptable in our school or community.


We talked about the importance of speaking to somebody if it happens to us or if we see it happening.


We have reminded our children that bullying is a behaviour that can hurt inside emotionally or on the outside physically and is intentionally repeated over time.


A huge thankyou to our Bully Busters who continue to spread the message of 'making a noise,' across school.




