This is what we have been learning this week!

Nursery:

We have listened to the story of when Mary and Joseph travelled to Bethlehem and thought about how Mary and Joseph felt on their long journey. We have loved Smile for a Mile, Squiggle while you Wriggle and Dough disco this week. In our maths we have been learning new number rhymes

Reception:

Reception have had lots of fun exploring toys in a workshop this week. Some of the toys we played with were over 100 years old! We talked about what material each toy was made from. Thankyou Mrs Martin for sharing your toys and your time with us this week. We are learning to read and we are practising our writing every day! In maths we have been making sets of 4 and learning the part, part, whole model.

Year 1:

We have used the enquiry triangle to find out about Windrush. We have been solving simple problems in maths. In Science we have been investigating the properties of materials.

Year 2:

Cop 29- We have discussed climate change and the impact it is having on the world. We have thought about how we can help to prevent this happening. We have made pledges. In RE we have thought about the history of the poppy and in maths we have continued to practise adding a one- digit number to a digit number, crossing ten. We have revisited the language of position and movement.
