PUPIL VOICE SNAPSHOTS

This is what we have been learning this week!

Nursery:

We have listened to the story of The Annunciation and thought about how Mary felt when the Angel Gabriel visited her.

We have been rehearsing our Christmas Nativity songs.

Reception:

We have mad magic rhyming spell for Meg and we have been able to write the words.

We have been investigating whether items will sink or float in Meg's cauldron.

Year 1:

We have used the enquiry triangle to find out about Windrush. We have used the part/ whole model to find out total amounts in maths. In Science we have been investigating whether materials are absorbent or non-absorbent.

Year 2:

We took part in a very exciting History Workshop yesterday. We learnt all about air raids, Anderson shelters, evacuees and rationing. We had a very busy day and learnt so much!

ADVENT

This Sunday is the first Sunday of Advent. We will be lighting our first candle on the Advent Wreath on Monday and the children will be making their Advent Promises.

The Travelling Cribs will be going home and we hope that you enjoy sharing the prayers and reflections with your children

During Advent we talk to the children about the true meaning of Christmas and how Advent is a really special time. As a Catholic school we talk about church and how our Parishes are also preparing for Christmas.

Advent is a lovely time for children to be in church. Our three Parishes will also be lighting their wreaths and very soon the cribs will be ready.





Christmas Crib:

As the children continue their journey of faith during Advent, each class will be sending home a 'Christmas Crib' prayer bag containing a wooden crib, a tea light and a special prayer to share together as a family during this important part of the liturgical year.

Each class has one 'Christmas Crib' prayer bag and therefore we ask that it is returned to school the next day to ensure that as many families as possible have the opportunity to share in this experience during Advent.

Your child will take home either the 'Travelling Rosary', the 'Christmas Crib' or the 'Lenten Cross' at some point during the academic year.

The response from families who took home the 'Travelling Rosary' was very positive; it was a lovely opportunity for the children to share with you how we pray in school. I am sure that those families who now receive the 'Christmas Crib' will experience a similar time of prayer and reflection this Advent.

History Workshop:

On Thursday, Year 2 travelled back in time to find out what life was like for children in 1940. We learnt about rationing, evacuation, air raids and Anderson shelters. The children learnt so much as they crafted, quizzed, discussed and role played and all went home excited to tell their parents about what they had found out. Workshops like these are such a valuable and memorable way of bringing History to life.
