Dear Parents/ Carers,

First of all I want to say a huge thankyou to all of the children and parents who attended Mass at St Ann's and St Chad's at the weekend. It was really lovely to see so many families at the Masses and our choir sang beautifully at St Ann's.

Fr Louis was quite overwhelmed and he wants me to pass on his thanks to you all. We both agree that the behaviour of all the children was fantastic and his wish now is that children and families continue to come to church.

Fr Tony at Christchurch is also keen to welcome more children to Mass.

Going to church is such an important part of our Catholic faith and even though our young children don't yet fully understand the whole Mass it is an important time for them to take 'time out' and to be surrounded by prayer.

My local Parish is St Ann's and I look forward to seeing some more children from Cheadle Catholic attend regularly.

A message from St Ann's Parish:

CHILDREN'S ADORATION will now take place at **St Ann's** on the third Friday of the month at 5pm followed by refreshments in the hall. Let your children and grandchildren experience the closeness of God by bringing them to a short time of adoration specially adapted for them.

At every 5pm Saturday Mass, children are invited to help with reading the Bidding Prayers, doing the Offertory and doing the collection. Please will any children who would like to help with that try to arrive a little bit early and make themselves known to Lorraine or Carol.

The 11am Mass is a little less organised so far, but children are also welcome to help if they make themselves known to the welcomers.

There will be **CHILDREN'S LITURGY** at the 11am Mass every Sunday of Advent. This starts this week and the first session will be led by Mrs Glynn.

Sat 2nd December: 3.30-4.30pm: Advent Wreath making session followed by 5pm Mass.

Advent:

This Sunday is the first Sunday of Advent. We will be lighting our first candle on the Advent Wreath on Monday and the children will be making their Advent Promises.

The Travelling Cribs will be going home today and we hope that you enjoy sharing the prayers and reflections with your children

During Advent we talk to the children about the true meaning of Christmas and how Advent is a really special time. As a Catholic school we talk about church and how our Parishes are also preparing for Christmas. Advent is a lovely time for children to be in church. Our three Parishes will also be lighting their wreaths and very soon the cribs will be ready.

Christmas Crib:

As the children continue their journey of faith during Advent, each class will be sending home a 'Christmas Crib' prayer bag containing a wooden crib, a tea light and a special prayer to share together as a family during this important part of the liturgical year.

Each class has one 'Christmas Crib' prayer bag and therefore we ask that it is returned to school the next day to ensure that as many families as possible have the opportunity to share in this experience during Advent.

Your child will take home either the 'Travelling Rosary', the 'Christmas Crib' **or** the 'Lenten Cross' at some point during the academic year.

The response from families who took home the 'Travelling Rosary' was very positive; it was a lovely opportunity for the children to share with you how we pray in school. I am sure that those families who now receive the 'Christmas Crib' will experience a similar time of prayer and reflection this Advent.
