This is what we have been learning this week!

Nursery:

We have been thinking about our Family Tree. We can talk about the people in our families.
We have looked for signs of Winter and have noticed that there are no leaves on the trees.

Reception:

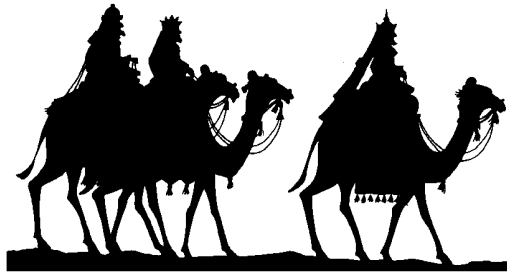

May I also remind you that you are advised to make 6 selections of schools. The closing date for Reception applications is **15th January 2023**

Applications for nursery places for September 2023 (born between **1 September 2019 and 31 August 2020**) are also being accepted online. Closing date is **31st March 2023**.
