This is what we have been learning this week!

Nursery:

The 'Wheels on the Bus,' has been our Nursery rhyme of the week. We have been practising our cutting skills and made our own buses from 3D shapes. In our Religion lessons we have listened to the story of Jesus being lost and found in the Temple

Reception:

We are all Super heroes! This week we have designed super veggies and talked about their powers. In our Religion lessons we have remembered the story of the Epiphany and how the three Wise Men travelled very far to visit Jesus. In maths we have learnt different ways to make 5.

Year 1:

This week we have started to make our own e-books in our computing lesson. In English we have been reading the story of 'Lost & Found' and have written some adjectives to describe the penguin. In Science we have used Google Earth to look at the Arctic and Antarctic.

In maths we have been learning how to make 'teen' numbers using 10s and 1s.

Year 2:

In Geography we went for a walk in our local area and looked for human and physical features in the environment. In Science we have been learning about the basic needs of animals and humans and what they need to survive.

READING:

Today there was great excitement in the library as the Reading Champions received a parcel. It didn't take them long to guess what might be inside. It was our favourite kind of delivery: books!

Over the Christmas holidays we had won a competition and Oxford Children's Books had sent us twenty four lovely new books for the school library.

The children soon delved in and are very excited to see them added to our school bookshelves next week.
