School Finances:

I have to share with parents that, at the end of October, the local authority fixed deal for gas came to an end. Our bills have skyrocketed and there is no extra funding or subsidy from government. This cost far exceeds the figure we budgeted for, even though we erred very much on the side of caution, and means we have to use funds initially budgeted for other areas.

We have also received a large bill from the diocese for our building fund contribution (made up of the suggested £15 per child). We have received just a fraction of this amount so ask that, if you are able, you consider making this payment using Pay 360.
