


Mrs Windsor

1 Minute Maths!



We would like to tell you about a new app that is free to download from the app store or from the White Rose Maths website. It is designed for use both in class and at home.

The new 1-Minute Maths app helps to build greater number confidence and fluency. ALL in 1 minute chunks.

Perfect for the children in the infants.

This first version of the app is aimed at Year 1 /2 children and focuses on addition, subtraction and subitising. Children can choose any topic they want to try. They then answer a unique series of questions (so it's a different set of questions every time). If they're struggling with a question, a 'Hint' button will give a helpful clue by showing the question in a different but familiar way.

When the one minute's up, they'll see a feedback screen telling them how they've done

Give it a go and let us know what you think.

The free mobile app is available for Apple/IOS, Android and Kindle. Have fun!

COVID UPDATE

The latest guidance from the government states:

'You will not be required to wear a face covering, including in communal areas of schools, but the government suggests you continue to wear one in crowded and indoor spaces where you may come into contact with people you do not normally meet.'

However, as we still have increasing rates of covid within our schools we are asking that visitors and staff continue to wear face coverings when moving around inside the school or in communal areas. Although not compulsory, we would also welcome the wearing of face masks outside of school until our rates start to drop.

We are hoping to move back to face to face assemblies after half term and if the rates within schools drop we will look at re introducing Thumbs Up mornings and 'Drop Everything & Read.' These two school events will involve inviting parents back into school......There will be more information to follow after half term. Let us all pray that we are over the worst now and that we can begin to open our doors once more.

WhatsApp

Many of you are members of WhatsApp or other social media groups that connect parents in a particular class. Ideally, the group chats are useful places to share information regarding your child's day in school; receiving updates and reminders about school events; as well as sharing parenting advice.

Most of the time, these group chats can be a great resource and an enjoyable place to be in. But, as with many things in life, there are those unfortunate times where someone in the group may say something inappropriate.

In order to prevent any miscommunications, here are some guidelines:

- If you have a query or concern about the teacher or the school leadership always **talk to them directly**. Face to face is always the best way and is the only way that issues can be resolved.
- When writing, remember that that whatever you say on social media may be forwarded to someone else, and in a few minutes it may be seen by half of the school.

Stockport Family at Cheadle Catholic Schools

Stockport Family is an integrated service for children, young people and families. Strong relationships and the development of an integrated 'Team Around the School,' are the heart of Stockport Family.

All schools have a named Social Worker, a named Stockport Family Worker and a School Nurse who provide advice, guidance and support to families who need it.

They can offer advice on children's sleep, diet, behaviour as well as advice on claiming benefits, parenting courses and mental health support.

If we have enough interest our team will also offer parent workshops on sleep, diet etc.

The named Social Worker for Cheadle Catholic Schools is Sonia Nunes.

The named Family Worker is Amy Buchan and our School Nurse is Sarah Capel. They are our Cheadle Catholic Stockport Family Support Team.

Our Support Team will be offering regular drop in sessions for parents and carers. During these sessions our Team will be available to talk to any parents/ carers who have any concerns at all about their children or families. The sessions will be very informal and you will not need to make an appointment. However, if you wish to speak to a member of the Team confidentially please contact me and I will make a separate appointment for you.

Our first drop in session will be on **Wednesday 2nd February 9am-11am.** The session will take place in the Junior School in their Faith Room (one of the mobile classrooms.) If you wish to attend, please report to school reception and we will direct you to the room.
