#### **PUPIL VOICE SNAPSHOTS**

This is what we have been learning this week!

#### **Nursery:**

Our Nursery Rhyme of the week has been, '5 little speckled frogs.' We have bounced the frogs off and onto the logs!

We have read the story, 'Is there anyone like me?' and have celebrated our differences.

In our RE lessons we have talked about how Jesus loves every single one of us no matter where we are from or who we are.

#### Reception:

In our Tales Toolkit sessions we have identified characters, setting, problem and solution in the Supertato story.

In maths we have ordered numbers 0-10 and identified 1 more/ 1 less.

In RE we have listened to to the story of Jesus getting lost in the Temple.

#### Year 1:

We have created our own speech bubbles in our writing. In maths we are comparing numbers to 20 and we have worked on 'greater than' and 'less than.'

In geography we have made season spinners. In DT today we are designing our own puppets.

In our RE lessons we have thought about stories in the Bible that tell us how Jesus looked after the sick and cared for the poor. We have thought about how we can help others who need help.

#### Year 2:

In art we have made group compositions in the style of our focus artist- Archimboldo and then we have sketched our designs.

In our English lessons we are reading the story of 'The Disgusting Sandwich.' We did some drama outside where we pretended that we each had a sandwich. Some terrible things happened to them!! This will help us to plan and write stories next week.

In maths we have learnt about coins and notes and have made amounts of money.

In our RE lessons we have listened to stories from the Bible about the miracles Jesus performed. This week we have focused on the story of The Ten Lepers.
