

Lenten Cross

Reception Parent Maths Mastery Workshop:

It was lovely to welcome so many Reception parents into school on Tuesday to take part in our Maths Mastery workshop with their children. We had over 70 parents/ grandparents take part!.....thankyou for your incredible support.

To help develop children's fluency we teach a daily 10-15 minutes 'Mastering Number' session separate to the main maths lesson. This programme is a DfE funded initiative run by the National Centre for Excellence in Maths Teaching (NCETM) through the maths hubs, and they have recently developed home learning materials as part of this. At the session parents found out more about their child's learning, played some simple fun games and took away a resource pack to use at home. The children really loved showing their parents/ grandparents their learning

School Library

We are really lucky to have a lending library and all the children love the experience of coming to the library and choosing their own books. It is a really important part of our school's Reading for Pleasure offer and also a vital part in teaching your children to love



reading. We understand that accidents happen and sometimes books are misplaced and we will always clear a child's lending record if a book is lost or damaged so that they can continue borrowing. However, this half term we have had to write off fifty books from our library system. As you can imagine, this has an impact on what your child can then borrow. If you think you might have a library book at home, no matter how long ago you borrowed it, please do send it back to school so we can put it back on the shelves for everyone to enjoy.

Attendance:

At Cheadle Catholic Schools we know that good attendance is crucial to children attaining well, making good progress and reaching their potential.

The vast majority of parents/carers bring their child/children to school regularly, and on time.

The Government's expectation is that all children should have an attendance figure of at least 95%

In order for you to keep track on your child's attendance we will now report their attendance figure to you half termly. Today you will receive a paper copy of your child's attendance to date (Reception to Year 2 children only). This will be found in an envelope in your child's book bag today.

Our whole school attendance target is 97%. This week our attendance is 95%
