Parent's Evening:

Our second parents' consultation evenings of the year will take place next week and we are delighted to say that we will be hosting our meetings face to face.

You should by now have booked your appointment on either **Tuesday March 15th 4.30-6.30pm or**

Thursday March 17th 4.30-6.30pm

Key Stage 1 class teachers (Y1 and Y2 teachers) will meet with parents in the hall, you are welcome to view your child's books and classroom before or after your appointment but we do ask that you are in the hall 5 minutes prior to your allocated appointment time.

Class 1BM books will be in the Year 1 area as After School Club will be held in the Class 1BM during parent's evenings.

Reception class teachers will meet with parents in the reception shared area and you are able to view your child's books and classroom before or after your allocated appointment time.

Nursery staff will meet with parents in the Nursery, we ask that you arrive 5 minutes before your appointment time and you will have the opportunity to view your child's learning journey and classroom before and after your allocated appointment time.

We have allowed 5 minutes per child and ask for your co-operation in keeping to this. You will appreciate that this important event is exclusively for parents; **therefore no children including junior children should be onsite for either meeting.**

There will be no childcare provision provided.

We ask that all parents/ carers wear a face mask at all times when in the school building unless you are exempt.

Attendance

School attendance at Cheadle Catholic Infant School has always been excellent and has always averaged around 97%. Currently our whole school attendance stands at 94%. Understandably covid has hugely impacted on all school attendances and schools have had to make allowances for children who have tested positive or who have been asked to isolate.

We do now, however, need to make a whole school effort to raise our attendance levels again. Good attendance and punctuality are an essential part of your child's success at school. Pupils who regularly miss school or arrive late fall behind in lessons and may not achieve their full potential.

Absence:

If your child is going to be absent you must contact the school office by telephone (0161 4858733) or email <u>admin@cheadle-inf.stockport.sch.uk</u> (NOT the headteacher email) on the first day of absence and every day thereafter.

If no contact is received the absence will be marked as unauthorised and you will receive a text or phone call from school.

The school day is divided into two sessions. If your child is unable to attend the a.m. session but is well enough/able to attend the p.m. session it is expected that every effort is made to do so to receive a p.m. attendance mark. Please email or telephone school in advance.

Medical Absence:

It is expected that medical/ dental appointments be made outside of the school day. If this is not possible your child must attend school before and after the appointment.

Attendance

If your child does not attend school regularly they may:

- Struggle to keep up with school work.
- Miss a vital part of a block of work, making it harder to keep up in subsequent lessons.
- Miss out on the social side of school life.
- Find it harder to make and keep friendships a vital part of growing up.
- Not make the progress they are capable of.

Leave of Absence

Permission for a leave of absence will only be given in exceptional circumstances and is granted at the discretion of the Headteacher.

Please make the request in writing by filling in a Leave of Absence form at least **4 weeks** in advance of the request. We may contact you to discuss this further and will respond in writing. If you continue to take the leave without permission or you do not make a request then the absence will be recorded as unauthorised.

Leave of absence will not be authorised unless there are exceptional circumstance.

If your child's absence is above 10% they are classed as a 'persistent absentee' and their absence and punctuality is monitored by the school who work closely with the Local Authority to achieve a high level of attendance. If you are worried about something or are having any difficulties getting your child to school, you can talk to the Headteacher.

Punctuality

All pupils are expected to be at school by 9am ready for the start of the day. Parents of pupils arriving after 9:05am must report to the office to provide a reason for their child's lateness. The pupil will need to be signed in and the minutes late will be recorded.

If your child is late for just 5 minutes each day this would equate to 3 days missed over a year.

90% attendance means that your child has missed 19 days in the school year.

Our next first drop in session will be on **Monday 14th March 9am-11am.** Our School Nurse will be on hand to offer advice about toileting, sleep and diet.

The session will take place in the Junior School in their Faith Room (one of the mobile classrooms.) If you wish to attend, please report to school reception and we will direct you to the room.

The session will be very informal and you will not need to make an appointment.

However, if you wish to speak to a member of the Team confidentially please contact me and I will make a separate appointment for you

Sonia (Social Worker) will also be available at the beginning of the day before school and will greet parents on the playgrounds with Mrs Fender and myself.
