Our Year 6 pupils also came across to share some reading with our Year 1 children.

It has been so wonderful to see all the children engaging with such enthusiasm and excitement this week as we know how important it is for us to foster a love of reading in these early years of school. We hope that they brought some of this positivity home with them and that this weekend you will find some time for reading together.

On Tuesday the children had a lovely treat as they were welcomed once more to the Reading Cafe. They were so excited to see the hall all set up like a real cafe but with one big difference- lots of different books to try! The Reading Champions also loved helping to set up the cafe and did a great job of engaging the Year 1 children in book talk and sharing what they love to read.

you! 






PSA EASTER BUNNY HOP
