

Dear Parents/ Carers,

Month of May:

May is the month dedicated to Mary, Mother of God. Pope Francis has asked us to

pray the Rosary every day throughout May 2022 for peace.

We will be discussing this with the children on Monday during our Monday Assembly and we will continue to pray and sign the Hail Mary every day.

During May, each class teacher will send home a prayer bag containing "The Travelling Rosary" with a different child each day.

Each class has one 'Prayer Bag', therefore we ask that it is returned to school the next day to ensure that as many families as possible have the opportunity to share in this experience during May.

Inside the 'Traveling Rosary' prayer bag, there will be cards with the words of the 'Our Father', 'Hail Mary' and 'Glory Be', a tea light and a set of children's wooden rosary beads.

• Light the candle and begin by holding the crucifix, making the sign of the cross.



- On the single bead, pray the 'Our Father'.
- On the set of 10 beads, pray the 'Hail Mary' 10 times.
- Finish by praying the 'Glory Be' and then make the sign of the cross.

I hope you find this a lovely opportunity during the liturgical year to reflect and pray with your children.

Sport's Mornings:

Weather permitting we will be welcoming parents into the school grounds on Tuesday 10th May for our Sport's Morning:

- 9.15am for Nursery 1 & FT children
- 10.30am for Reception
- Thursday 12th May 9.15am for Nursery 2 & FT children

The event will take place at the back of the school on the field.

We will ask parents to stand on the Mile path to watch.

The children will need to come into school wearing their PE kit including velcro trainers. They will also need a sun hat or cap and a water bottle. If the sun is shining we also ask that sun cream is applied before the children come to school.

We ask that all parents stay in the designated parent area on the path and DO NOT come over to the children whilst they are waiting for their race. We have 90 children to supervise and we need to know where they are and who they are with at all times.

We do give stickers to the children for first, second and third in the races and we also ensure that all children receive a sticker for taking part.

Hopefully the sun will shine and we will all have a wonderful morning!


School Uniform Reminder:

REMINDERS:

Homes for Ukraine Scheme

We understand that there are families in our school community who have applied to offer a home to people fleeing Ukraine under the government's Home for Ukraine scheme, and that sponsors could soon be welcoming their guests.

We would like to offer assistance to anyone hosting Ukrainian refugees by bringing together supplies needed to make their stay as comfortable as possible.

Laura Quigley, one of parent governors, has offered to coordinate this. Can we ask that if you are a successful sponsor, you email Laura at her governor email address (below) setting out as much information as you know about the refugees arriving and we will then put out a message to the school community requesting donations for the specific items needed. We hope to be able to offer clothing, bedding, toiletries, toys etc.

We will also request volunteers if needed to help with this effort, depending on the amount of assistance requested.

Travel Plan Agreement

As parents/carers of

I/we agree:

- To respect the decision not to allow parents' vehicles on to school grounds between 8:30-9:10am and 3:00- 4:00pm (start and end of day) to ensure the safety of all pupils.
- Not to stop or park on the School Keep Clear yellow zig-zag markings outside the school entrance/s, to ensure pupils have the best possible chance of being able to see to cross the road in safety.
- Not to park or stop on any corners, particularly those with double or single yellow lines, to ensure pupils have the best possible chance of being able to see to cross the road in safety.

- Always to ensure my child(ren) exit my vehicle on the side of the pavement.
- To ensure my vehicle does not block crossings points, such as places where there are dropped kerbs where families can cross more easily and safely.
- To ensure my vehicle does not block driveways of local residents.
- Not to block pavements whilst waiting for my child(ren) to come out of school, which would force pupils
 to walk in the road to get past.
- Where possible to park at Bruntwood Park; to park and stride.
- To ensure my younger children are kept under reasonable control whilst on school grounds.
- To not allow my child/children to scooter or cycle in the school playground.
- To respect the school's rules of allowing parents to drive into the school grounds by driving at no more than 5mph and being totally aware of all other road users on site particularly children.
- Not to park in the Staff/Visitors car park (unless permission is granted by school), bus lane and turning circle.
- Not to park in the disabled bays unless I or my child(ren) are disabled.
- To ensure the school is aware if my child(ren) is to be picked up by another person, and if this is the case, that the person will be aware of this agreement.
- Where possible, to support the School's Travel Plan by allowing my child(ren) to participate in walk to school initiatives, scoot or cycle to school.
- Where possible, to walk to school with my child(ren) to allow the development of road safety skills.
- To take part in a 'Park and Stride' scheme so that I park 5 or 10 minutes away from the school entrance and walk the rest of the way.

In return Cheadle Catholic Infant School agrees:

- To provide a waiting area within the school grounds for parents to wait to collect their children.
- To ensure children are handed over to parents at the end of the school day or another adult authorised by the parent where school have been notified of consent.
- Where children have not been collected, they will wait in the school office with a member of the school staff.

- To report cars which park illegally or dangerously outside the school to Stockport Police.
- That buses coming into school grounds to collect pupils, will be parked and have access to bus lane and turning circle.
- In the interests of safety, children will not be allowed to scooter or cycle in the school playground.
- To commit to the School's Travel Plan in the interests of both the safety and wellbeing of all staff, pupils and visitors of this school.
