Stockport Mental Health Support Team.

We are thrilled to announce that our school is now part of the **Stockport Mental Health Support Team**. This is a fantastic opportunity for our community and we're so pleased to have been given this support.

As part of this initiative, we have been assigned a dedicated Mental Health Practitioner, Olivia, who will be working with us in school every week. Olivia's role is to support parents of children who are dealing with mental health difficulties like anxiety and low mood.

Her support will include:

- **Therapy sessions** for children and their parents or carers.
- **Advice and signposting** to other services that can help you and your child.
- **Supporting our staff** in identifying and helping students with their mental health.

Olivia will also be running **parent workshops** on a variety of topics, including:

- Introduction to Challenging Behaviour Intervention
- Understanding Anxiety
- Transition Workshop

We want to assure you that parental consent will always be sought before any child works with Olivia.

Olivia will be in school on Tuesday to spend some time getting to know our children and staff. Over the next few weeks, we'll be hosting some coffee mornings and afternoons where you can come into school to meet Olivia in person and learn more about how she can support your family. We hope you will join us for this important opportunity.

Important: Please Update Your Contact Information

To ensure the safety of all our children, it is a legal requirement that we have your most current contact details on file.

Please make sure we have your up-to-date phone number and at least **two emergency contact numbers**. This is a vital part of our safeguarding duty. Having accurate information allows us to reach you quickly in an emergency.

School uses an App called School Gateway to communicate with Parents, all important messages will be sent via the App.

UNIFORM:

Please ensure that all items of clothing and snacks are labelled clearly.

PE trainers/ shoes should be black only with velcro straps please.

EQUIPMENT:

Please do not allow your children to play on the Reception/ Nursery equipment before or after school, this includes the school tricycles and scooters.

KEYRINGS

Only one small keyring to be put on school blue bags. Blue bags need to fit inside classroom trays. If your child's keyring is too large they will be asked to remove it.

SNACKS:

We are a healthy school and we ask that children bring in a healthy snack for morning break. Sweets, chocolate or crisps are not allowed. **Nuts of any kind** are not allowed in school.

We also ask that if you are bringing in grapes or cherries or large blubberies that they are sliced into quarters and the stone is removed. This is to protect children from choking.

Applications for nursery places for September 2025 are also being accepted online. Closing date is **31st March 2026**


