
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



As the world comes to terms with the sad news of the death of Pope Francis, we joined together in prayer to give thanks for the life of such a special leader.

The Month of May

May is the month dedicated to Mary, Mother of God.

During May, each class teacher will send home a prayer bag containing the 'Travelling Rosary' with a different child each day.

Each class has one 'prayer Bag, therefore we ask that it is returned to school the next day to ensure that as many families as possible have the opportunity to share in this experience during May.

Inside the 'Traveling Rosary' prayer bag, there will be cards with the words of the 'Our Father', 'Hail Mary' and 'Glory Be', a tea light and a set of children's wooden rosary beads.

- Light the candle and begin by holding the crucifix, making the sign of the cross.
- On the single bead, pray the 'Our Father'.
- On the set of 10 beads, pray the 'Hail Mary" 10 times.
- Finish by praying the 'Glory Be' and then make the sign of the cross.

We hope you find this a lovely opportunity during the liturgical year to reflect and pray with your children.



VE Day:

Next Thursday, 8th May, is the 80th anniversary of VE day and the end of World War 2 in Europe. In school we are going to be spending the day learning about how VE day was celebrated, why this is a significant historical event and praying for peace around the world. We will then have a celebration on the school field in the afternoon with a special treat!

Children can come to school in their own clothes or red, white and blue clothing to help us celebrate.

The children will have the opportunity to look at artefacts and investigate them with their friends earlier in the week when Mrs Martin comes to visit us on Wednesday.

We are also interested in any family connections you have to World War 2 so if your child would like to share a photo or name and a little bit of information about somebody who is special to them, we would love to hear about it, please see below:



As part of the celebrations, we are asking children to find out about people in their families who were alive during World War 2. Did you have a relative who fought in the war? Did someone in your family work in a munitions factory or experience life as an evacuee? Is there somebody who remembers the VE day celebrations of 1945? Perhaps your family has a experience of World War 2 from another country. We would love to hear about them and share it in our assembly on Thursday 8th May. 
And finally:
