

Monday Gospel Assembly:

In the Gospel reading from Sunday we heard how Jesus described himself as the good shepherd.

Now that the cases of covid have eased off in school (I hope I haven't spoken too soon!) we have been able to get our Year 2 children busy this week!



Rationale:

Here at Cheadle Catholic Infant & Junior Schools, our pupils enjoy a rich, creative curriculum with the aim of instilling a lifelong love of learning and the belief that nothing is impossible. We also believe that education is more than what's learnt in the classroom and our experiences outside it are just as important.

Children are further supported to become independent learners who are inspired to try out their own ideas, explore their own interests, to attempt new things and to take risks.


