



Dear Parents/Carers,

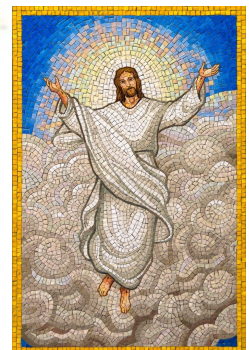

Please return your decorated bag during the **first week back after half term**.

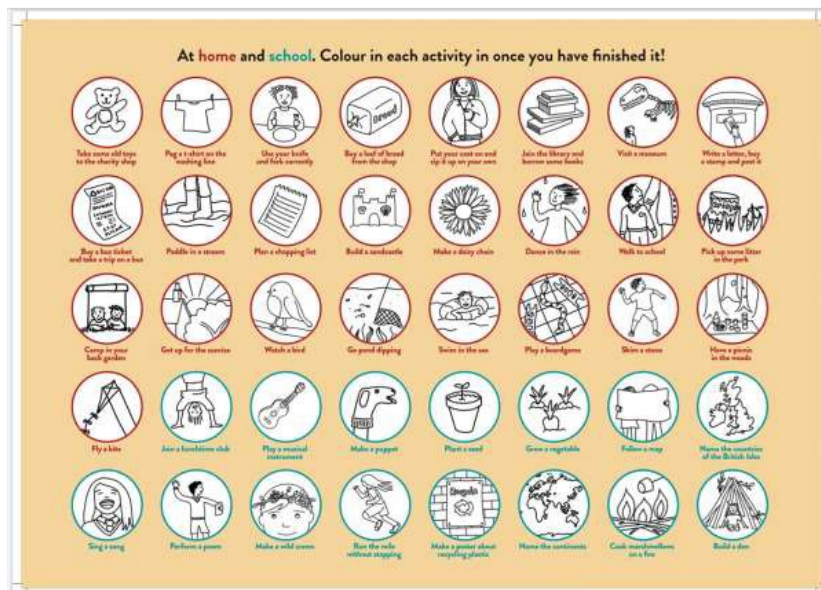
We can't wait to see all your amazing creations — thank you for helping make our Summer Fair extra special!
