IMC is centred around the early development of basic musical skills through singing, playing instruments and, most importantly, having fun!

Children will have a choice of beginner instruments to learn: pBbuzz, recorder or violin, alongside percussion and singing activities to develop basic skills and musicianship.

Stockport Music Service's Infant Music Centre is open to all children in school years 1 and 2 with the choir also open to reception children.

Infant Music Centre will run during term time on Thursdays from 4:00 - 6:00 pm and will be structured as follows:

- 4:00 - 4:45 - Choir - for all children, including reception.
- 4:45 - 5:00 - Break
- 5:00 - 6:00 - Instrumental, percussion & musicianship skills

Sessions will start on 30th September, but we are offering an open day for children to come and try out what we do. This will be 4:00 - 5:00 pm on:

- Thursday 21st July 2022

Termly music centre fee of £30.00 per child applies, with family discounts for siblings.

A one off fee of no more than £25 buys an recorder or pBbuzz and a music bag. Violins can be hired for £20 a term.

### **COVID 19 update**

It is being reported that cases of COVID are once again on the rise. Please see below for the latest government response 'Living with COVID' .

#### **“Children and young people (aged 18 years and under) who have symptoms of a respiratory infection, including COVID-19**

Children and young people with mild symptoms such as a runny nose, sore throat, or slight cough, who are otherwise well, can continue to attend their education setting.

Children and young people who are unwell and have a high temperature should stay at home and avoid contact with other people, where they can. They can go back to school, college or childcare, and resume normal activities when they no longer have a high temperature and they are well enough to attend.

**It is not recommended that children and young people are tested for COVID-19 unless directed to by a health professional.**

If a child or young person has a positive COVID-19 test result they should try to stay at home and avoid contact with other people for 3 days after the day they took the test, if they can.”

Please note that schools are no longer permitted to authorise pupils absence for them to isolate either before major events/ holidays or if someone in their household has COVID.

Please continue to pray for all those in our school and parish communities who are dealing with illness, loneliness, anxiety and bereavement. May they find comfort in the knowledge that they are in our thoughts and prayers.

### School Uniform Shopping:

As we begin the last half term of the year I know that many of you will be thinking about uniform for next year.

I have listed below our school uniform list.

Children are expected to wear the full uniform each day except on their PE day or Forest School day; on this day they can come dressed in the PE kit or Forest School kit described.

Forest School Kit	Yellow t-shirt, black shorts/ joggers Grey school cardigan/ jumper or black fleece Wellies/ Velcro trainers (weather dependent) Waterproof coat and trousers Hat, gloves, scarf/ sun hat (weather dependent)
<p>Please note that we do not consider any form of jewellery to be suitable for children in school for safety reasons.</p> <p>Earrings are NOT permitted in school.</p> <p>Grey or yellow hair ornaments are acceptable but must be of a sensible size (no big bows).</p> <p>Makeup of any sort is not allowed  Nail varnish is not allowed</p>	

As you can see, from September we will have a Forest School uniform which is very similar to our outdoor PE kit. Black fleeces can be purchased from any of our school uniform providers and they can be purchased with or without the school logo.

Please note: **School ties and white shirts/ blouses will not be part of our school uniform from September.**



If you have any white shirts or blouses that you wish to donate to a worthy cause please bring them into school the week beginning July 11<sup>th</sup> and we will ensure that they are sent to children who need them.
