## **ONLINE SAFETY:**

Two weeks ago I mentioned in the newsletter that we had been made aware of an online game called Poppy Playtime. It has been reported that some of the content is extremely violent and completely inappropriate for children. Unfortunately some of our children have mentioned this game again in school.

I would urge you to please check your children's devices to see what they have been playing and to make sure that parental controls and locks are on all devices.

Please ask your children daily about the games they are playing and talk to them about how to stay safe online. For some really helpful advice and activities please take a look at the CEOP website.

The CEOP Education team is part of the National Crime Agency. They run a national online safety education programme, which provides training, resources and information for children and young people aged 4 - 18, their families and professionals who work with them.

This website is a part of their programme.

The characters on this website also feature in Jessie & Friends, a three episode animated series for 4-7 year olds. The Jessie & Friends animations are free to download and come with fun, engaging lesson plans for teachers and other professionals, and advice for parents and carers on watching them with children at home.

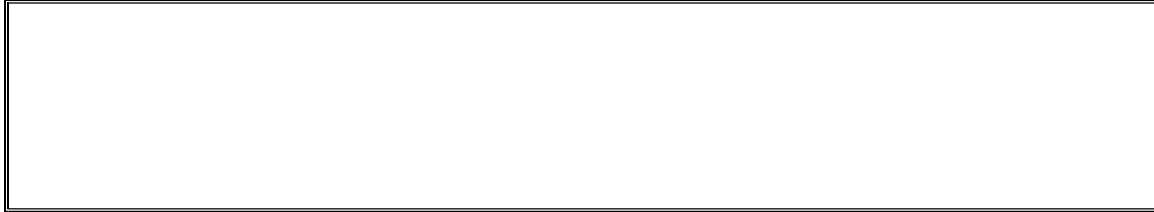
#### **School Uniform Shopping:**

As we begin the last half term of the year I know that many of you will be thinking about uniform for next year.

I have listed below our school uniform list.

Children are expected to wear the full uniform each day except on their PE day or Forest School day; on this day they can come dressed in the PE kit or Forest School kit described.

Winter	<p>Grey pinafore dress/skirt/trousers/ shorts</p> <p>Short sleeved yellow polo shirt</p> <p>Grey cardigan/jumper with gold trim</p> <p>Grey/white/black socks or tights</p> <p>Black velcro shoes (no laces) - NOT boots, open toe sandals or high heels</p> <p>Warm, waterproof coat</p>
Summer	<p>Lemon/white check dress</p> <p>Grey pinafore dress/skirt/trousers/ shorts</p> <p>Short sleeved yellow polo shirt</p> <p>Grey cardigan/jumper with gold trim</p> <p>Grey/white/black socks</p> <p>Black Velcro shoes (no laces) - NOT boots, open toe sandals or high heels</p> <p>Waterproof coat</p> <p>Sun hat/ cap</p>
P.E. Kit	<p>Yellow t-shirt</p> <p>Black shorts</p> <p>Black joggers/ leggings for winter</p> <p>Grey school cardigan/ jumper or black fleece</p> <p>Velcro trainers (no laces)</p>
Forest School Kit	<p>Yellow t-shirt, black shorts/ joggers</p> <p>Grey school cardigan/ jumper or black fleece</p> <p>Wellies/ Velcro trainers (weather dependent)</p> <p>Waterproof coat and trousers</p> <p>Hat, gloves, scarf/ sun hat (weather dependent)</p>
<p>Please note that we do not consider any form of jewellery to be suitable for children in school for safety reasons.</p> <p>Earrings are NOT permitted in school.</p> <p>Grey or yellow hair ornaments are acceptable but must be of a sensible size (no big bows).</p> <p>Makeup of any sort is not allowed</p> <p>Nail varnish is not allowed</p>	



As you can see, from September we will have a Forest School uniform which is very similar to our outdoor PE kit. Black fleeces can be purchased from any of our school uniform providers and they can be purchased with or without the school logo.

Please note: **School ties and white shirts/ blouses will not be part of our school uniform from September.**

If you have any white shirts or blouses that you wish to donate to a worthy cause please bring them into school the week beginning July 11<sup>th</sup> and we will ensure that they are sent to children who need them.
