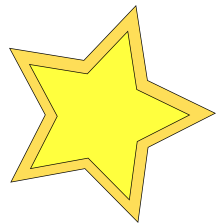

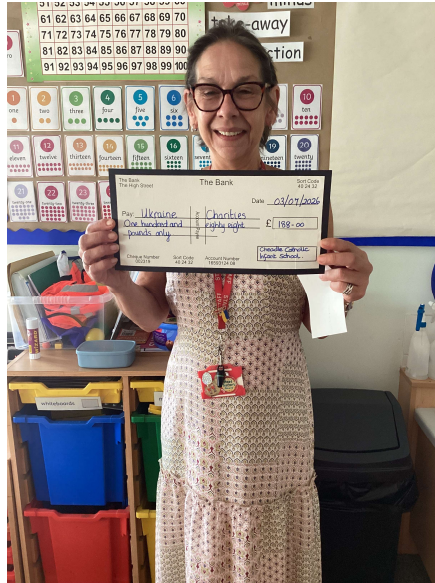


Year 2 Fest:

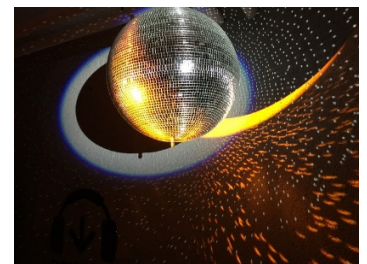

Family Support Vouchers

As part of Stockport Council's delivery of the UK government Crisis and Resilience Fund, vouchers are being issued to families with school-age children who receive income-based free school meals, those in early years with equivalent eligibility, and those households in receipt of Local Council Tax Support.

Eligible families are receiving a Family Support Voucher worth £50 per eligible child, which can be redeemed at a Post Office. This is to help with the cost of household bills and essentials.

Be sure to check for your voucher in the post (if we don't have your email address) and by email from 16 July 2026.
