Out of this vast tonnage around 1.2 million tonnes is sent unnecessarily to landfill.

- Blankets
- Table Cloths
- Linens
- Cushions
- Carpets
- Suitcases
- Books
- Bric a Brac
- Clothes Hangers
- Electricals

The Rag Bag collection bin has been positioned between the Infant & Junior School near the front entrance and will be open for collections from September
