



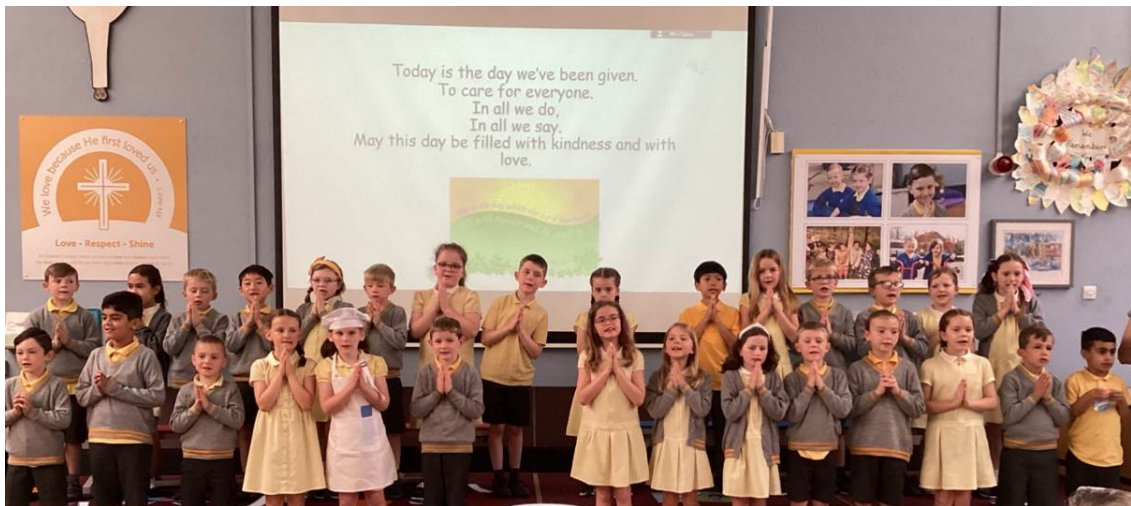

We are currently seeking a responsible and caring individual to join our community-led bus team as a Bus Chaperone. This role is crucial in ensuring the safety and well-being of our students during their daily commute.

The applicant must be available from the first bus stop in the morning until the bus reaches the school, and from the school in the afternoon until the last stop.

Key Responsibilities:

- Supervise students during their journey to and/or from school.
- Assist students in safely boarding and disembarking the bus, (where necessary).
- Ensure all students are seated.
- Maintain order and enforce bus rules and values.
- Provide assistance to the bus driver with required stops.
- Communicate with parents as necessary regarding student issues.
- Escort the children from the bus to the Infant school office/ Junior school hall.
- Collect the children from the Infant school office / Junior school hall.
