Francesca helped her Grandma to bake a wheat sheaf of bread, to bring into school for our Harvest festival. Well done Francesca, this is amazing!


### **Cafod Family Fast Day**

As part of our home - school partnership we are always striving to develop further opportunities for the children to share with you how we pray in school.





home a prayer bag containing "The Travelling Rosary" with a different child each day. Each class has one 'Prayer Bag', therefore we ask that it is returned to school the next day to ensure that as many families as possible have the opportunity to share in this experience during October, Advent and Lent. Teachers will ensure that <u>all</u> children at some point during the school year are able to participate in one of these reflections as a family.

Inside the 'Traveling Rosary' prayer bag, there will be cards with the words of the 'Our Father', 'Hail Mary' and 'Glory Be', a tea light and a set of children's wooden rosary beads.

- Light the candle and begin by holding the crucifix, making the sign of the cross.
- On the single bead, pray the 'Our Father'.
- On the set of 10 beads, pray the 'Hail Mary" 10 times.
- Finish by praying the 'Glory Be' and then make the sign of the cross.

I hope you find this a lovely opportunity during the liturgical year to reflect and pray with your children.
