On Tuesday, Mrs Martin led the Rosary with our Year 2 children. She was impressed with how thoughtful and respectful in prayer our children are.

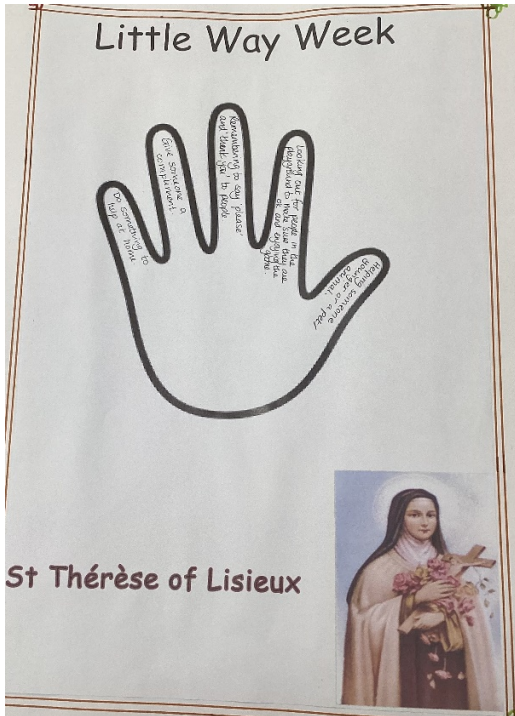

REMINDERS:

Scooters/ Bikes: Please ensure your children **do not ride** on their scooter/ bikes/ heellies/ roller boots etc once on school playgrounds. Thank you.

Please turn off your car engines whilst waiting outside of school, especially at Breakfast School drop-off. Not only does it help us all breathe easier, but it can also help you avoid a fine, as idling is an offense

Site Security:

We appreciate your cooperation in helping us maintain a safe and secure environment for all our pupils and the wider community. We kindly ask that you exit the school site right after drop-off and collection. Our commitment to security means the gates will be locked at 9:10 am and 3:40 pm. Please be sure to leave the grounds before these times and discourage children from playing on the trim trail or other school equipment after school hours.

Healthy Eating:

We encourage healthy eating to support your child's learning throughout the day. Please help us by sending only healthy snacks to school, such as fruit, vegetables, crackers, or cheese.

Please do not send in crisps, chocolate, sweets, or pastries.
