These treasures were the Catholic Social Teaching Principles.

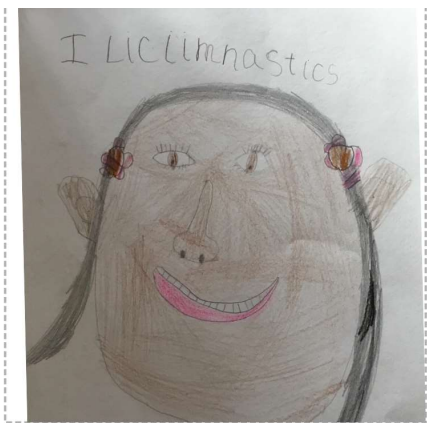
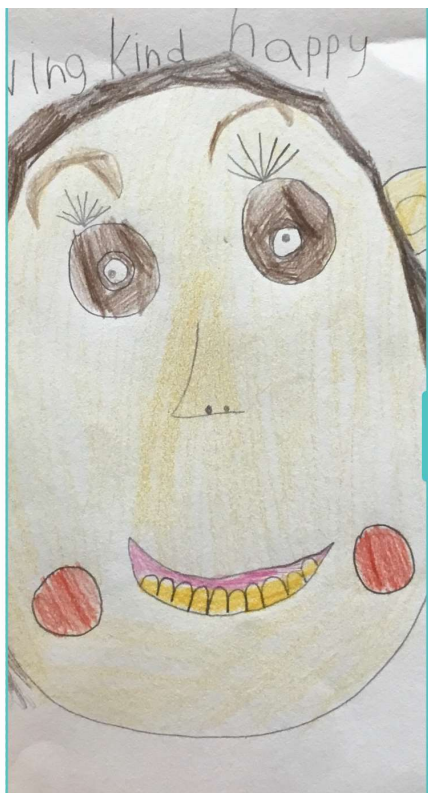
- Life and Dignity of the Human Person 🕊️

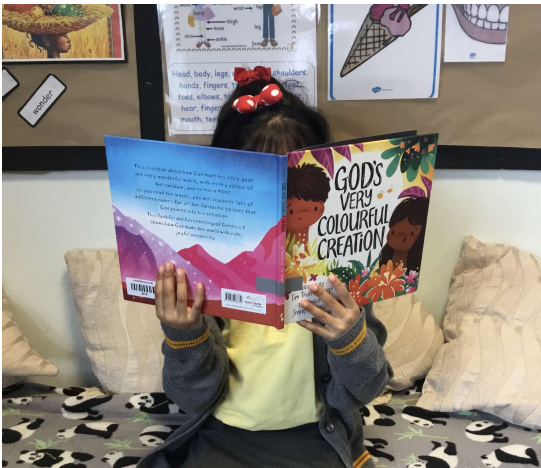

Thank you to everyone who joined us for our coffee morning on Tuesday to meet Olivia. We hope the session was useful.

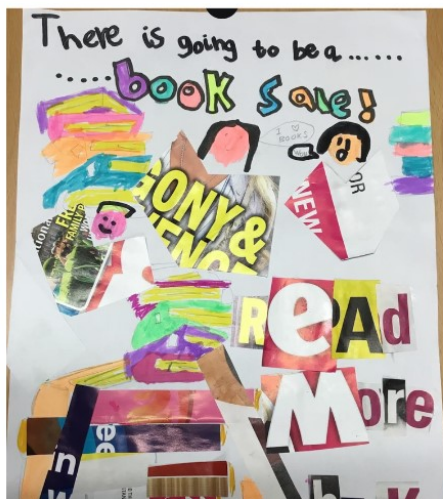
