- Tidiness: Please leave the shed tidy after your visit.
- Donations: Please **DO NOT** leave used uniform in the shed. We will send out a specific request for donations when we need to restock.

Parking:

I am afraid to say that despite repeated concerns, dangerous parking and driving continue to be a serious issue outside the school. I am disappointed to report that both Mrs. Fender and I witness these unsafe practices daily. We urge you to plan for an earlier arrival and pickup. This will allow you sufficient time to park safely, or even to walk a short distance, prioritising the safety of all our children.

Here are some important reminders:

No-Parking Zones: There are permanent **parking restrictions** on Kew Drive and parts of Conway Road. Please do not park on these roads at any time.

Parking Regulations: For the safety of everyone, please **do not park** on double yellow lines, zigzag lines, or on pavements. When parking on local roads, please ensure your vehicle is parked safely and legally.

Infant School Car Park: This car park is **reserved for children who are blue badge holders only**.

Breakfast Club: Parents dropping off children at Breakfast Club should **not use the Infant staff car park**, as staff need access at all times. Please park on local roads without restrictions or in the bus lane or on the turning circle.

Disabled Bays: All disabled parking bays must be kept clear at all times.

End-of-Day Pick Ups

Gate Closure: The gates to the Infant School site will be **locked from 2:30 PM to 3:15 PM**. Please do not queue outside the gates before 3:15 PM. This is to ensure emergency vehicles and After School staff have clear access. If you are found queuing, you will be asked to move your car.
