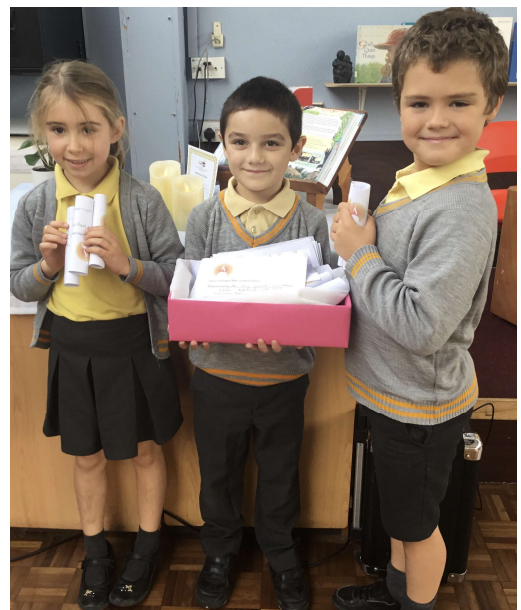
At Cheadle Catholic Infant School we **love** and **respect** each other.
