Key Skills

- To pay attention to more than one thing at a time.
- To use our word of the week to widen vocabulary.

- To get out and return some equipment safely and independently in PE.
- To recognise words with the same initial sound e.g. mummy and money.
- To write letters from our names using the correct letter formation.
- To know the last number when counting tells us the total.
- To describe a sequence of events using words suck as, first, then , next etc.
- Talk about the differences between materials.
- Creating complex stories independently using small world equipment.
- Use shapes to represent objects when drawing.
