RE

English

This week we will look at non-chronological reports (include heading, subheadings, paragraphs, pictures with labels and a fact box.) The children will write their own report based on one of the animals from our class book

Maths



This week we will introduce height. Using the language of - small, smaller, smallest, tall, taller, tallest - the children will be encouraged to order from shortest to longest objects they find in the classroom. Number formation and writing our numbers as words.

Science



This week in school is Science Week. The children will be involved in a variety of activities including investigating scientists - discussing who they are and what they do.

Geography



This week the children will look at continents of the world and the continent we are in. The children will share a map of the world and as a class name the continents. We will recap on the town and country we live in. Children can bring in any postcards from home showing a variety of countries from around our world.

PE



Our PE days are on **Wednesday** and **Thursday**. The children are allowed to wear their PE kits in school on these days. On Wednesday with Mr Helsby the children will take part in a variety of team games. On Thursday we will work within a team with Mrs O'Hare. Please can your child wear shorts on this day.
