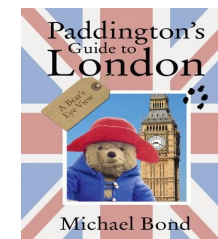
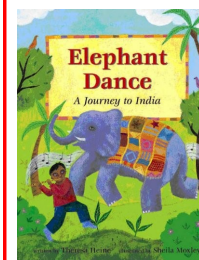
- We will learn about London and India through a selection of stories.
