- We will recognise, and describe special times or events with our family.
- We will talk about things which we have observed such as plants, animals and natural objects.

- We will investigate changes in our natural environment.

<u>Key Skills</u>

- Begin to select and use resources with/without help (Challenge Books)
- Begin to accept the needs of others
- Begin to read and write CVC words , linking sounds to letters
- (introduction to reading books and Guided reading sessions)
- Join in with rhymes and poems, and enjoy sharing books.
- Begin to use Tales Toolkit to "mark make" our own stories (Use of DEAL)
- Continue to develop understanding and use of phonics in Read Write Inc scheme
- Begin to recall events and put them in time order (use of a Memory Box)
- Compare amounts and understand the composition of numbers up to 5
- Find 1 more/ 1 less from a group of 5/10
- Recognise and develop the language of 2D and 3d shapes
- Develop subitizing skills.
- Continue to develop fine motor skills and use of scissors.
