## R.E. - Families and Celebrations

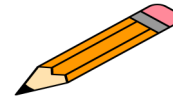
- Know that we all belong to a family. Think about how we can love and help each other.

- Use adjectives to improve our sentences.

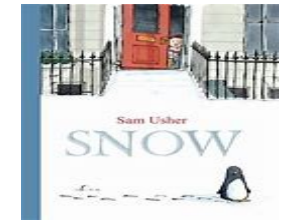
## PSHE
