### RE



This week we will complete the Christmas story, hearing the story of the Wise men following a star and visiting baby Jesus in the stable in Bethlehem.

### English

### Maths



This week we will make teen numbers using tens and ones. The children will also count out accurately amounts from 11 - 16. We will recap on number bonds and use this information when adding 2 sets of numbers together.  
Number formation and writing our numbers as words.

### Science



This half term we will look at "Polar Regions". This week the children will use a variety of sources to gain information about the region.

### Geography



This week we will look at and discuss the weather. What weather is and the different types of weather we have.  
We will take a walk around the school grounds looking at the weather and how it can affect our area. We will use our senses to describe the weather.

### PE



Our PE days are on **Wednesday** and **Thursday**. The children are allowed to wear their PE kits in school on these days.  
On Thursday we have dance- your child must wear shorts on this day.

### Art/DT
