<p>Geography</p>  <p>This week the children will find out the weather forecast for our local area. They will look at weather symbols and what they mean. They will predict a weekly weather forecast.</p>	<p>PE</p>  <p>Our PE days are on Wednesday and Thursday The children are allowed to wear their PE kits in school on these days.
