

Year 1 - Week Beginning 20.05.2024

RE



This week the children will hear how the friends of Jesus continued His mission after Pentecost. We will discuss ways we can help spread the mission of God.

We will also follow the Tens:Ten curriculum for weekly collective worship.

English



This week we will focus our time with set 1, 2 and 3 Read Write Inc phonics. The children will work through a variety of sounds in real words and "alien" words. They will be encouraged to use Fred Talk to help decode the words. This is in preparation for the Phonic Screening test that is planned for the week beginning 10th June.

Maths



This week the children will find a quarter of a shape and an amount. They will use counters to help them visually see an amount split into 4.

Number formation and writing our numbers as words.

Science



This week we will look at the main stages of the life cycle of a butterfly from an egg through to a fully-grown butterfly.

Geography



We will recap all the work we have done on the continents, polar regions, northern and southern hemisphere and the equator, and where they are in the world.

PE



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Our PE days are on **Wednesday** and **Thursday**. The children are allowed to wear their PE kits in school on these days.
