<u>Maths</u>  This week we will order and write numbers from 0 - 10. We will look at how we write numbers in word form. We will also count forwards from a given number.	<u>Science</u>  We will discuss a variety of foods and choose our favourite and our least favourite. We will collect the data and record it on a tally chart.
<u>Geography</u>  This week we will introduce the concept of human and physical features. Looking at man-made structures and those that we would find naturally in our environment.	<u>PE/Music</u>  Our PE days are on Wednesday and Thursday. The children are allowed to wear their PE kits in school on these days. <u>On Thursday we have gymnastics - your child must wear shorts on this day as they will be using apparatus.</u> Music is every Wednesday.
