Literacy



- We will learn new sounds, green words and red words in our phonics groups.

Mathematics

- We will sing a range of number rhymes and songs.

- We will explore the concept of heavier and lighter. We will use the weighing scales and a range of objects to see which are heavier and lighter. How do you know? What happens to the scale?
- We will play a Jolly Christmas postman track game to 10.
- We will use 4 squares to show different patterns of 4.
- Maths of the day: we will focus on counting and cardinality by counting how many times we can bounce a ball, throw and catch a beanbag etc.
- We will practice our letter formation outdoors using chalk.
