

RE/RSE/PSHE



- This week we will focus on ways in which we can show kindness to others. We will have a circle time to discuss times we have shown kindness. We will talk about how we can forgive each other.
- RSE- All the feelings-Using pictures and short stories of Freddy Teddy and his friends experiencing different feelings, children will discuss how they are feeling, what feelings can look like in their bodies and what contributes to their feelings. They will also work on empathy and how to help others experiencing difficult feelings.

Literacy



- Our text this week is 'Here comes the Aliens.'

- Writing a recipe for alien soup.
- Phonics- reading and writing simple sentences using the sounds we have learnt in our phonics groups.

Mathematics

- We will explore odd and even numbers using the Numicon shapes.
- Children will use playdough and butterfly templates to show double numbers.
- We will roll a dice and add that amount of pegs to a peg board. We will then double the amount.
- Maths of the day: planet game- We will move along a track to collect the space junk (balls and bean bags) and return it to our planets. How much junk can you collect in a minute?
- Weighing moon rocks- Can you find objects that are heavier than the moon rocks?
