Literacy



- Our text this week is 'Jack and the Beanstalk'.
- Phonics- We will learn to new 'special friends'. We will be reading and writing simple sentences using the sounds we have learnt in our phonics groups.

- Labelling the life cycle of a bean.

Mathematics

- We will explore addition. We will drop 10 double sided counters on to the table. How many red ones can we see? How many yellow? How many altogether. We will model using the addition sign to write calculations.
- Tally chart of favourite fruit.
- We will measure the giants footprints using cubes, how many cubes long is it? We will draw around our own foot, how many cubes long is our foot?
- Maths of the day: Children will have a large 10's frame outdoors, They will search the outdoor area for numbers 0-10. When they find a number they will show that amount on the 10's frame.
