- We will introduce the children to our new topic 'Sorrow and Joy.'
- We will think about the ways we can show kindness to others.
- We will read the story 'I am sorry'.
- We will listen to and talk about the Bible story of Zacchaeus.

Literacy



- Our text this week is 'Whatever Next!' by Jill Murphy
- We will learn new sounds, special friends and red words and read in our phonics groups.
- We will act out the story of Whatever next. We will hot seat baby bear to ask him all about his trip to the Moon.
- We will write lists of what baby bear took to the Moon.

Mathematics

- We will practice writing Chinese numbers in red and gold glitter.
- We will focus on the composition of 6 and 7 using the part part whole model and 2 different coloured counters.
- We will use 2D and 3D shapes to build rockets for baby bear.
- We will use egg boxes to make sets of 6 using 2 different items. What can you see? E.g. 4 cars and 2 bears, 4 and 2 makes 6.
- We will play bingo by matching different representations of numbers. E.g. 5 fingers, 2 counters etc
- Maths of the day: Children will take it in turns to choose a number- children will then show that number on their fingers using 5 and a bit. Then in pairs children will roll the ball to each other to reach their target number. (6, 7, 8, 9 and 10)
