Literacy



- This week our text is 'Stickman' by Julia Donaldson.
- We will write CVC words using our 'Fred Fingers'.
- We will learn new sounds and red words in our phonics groups.
- We will read our new RWI books.
- We will use our imagination to pretend we are Stickman. We will go on the same journey as stickman, exploring each setting, what can we see? How do we feel? We will then draw a story map to show our journey.
- Word of the week- place
- Mark making in the sand with sticks.

Mathematics

- We will sing a range of number rhymes and songs.
- This week we will be exploring composition.
- We will use the part part whole model to find ways of making 5. E.g. 4 is a part of 5 and 1 is a part of 5. 4 and 1 makes 5.
- We will be putting 5 parts together to make the whole Stickman.
- We will have a challenge to make a house using construction materials, that is big enough to fit Stickman in.
- We will use lolly sticks to make 2D shapes.
- Maths of the day: We will focus on using different parts of our whole body to move in different ways. E.g. hop on one leg.
- Outdoor stick patterns.



Understanding the World

- We will be thinking about places. What places do we like to visit? What is it like at different places?
- We will go on an imaginary journey to visit the different 'places' in the Stickman story e.g. beach, park. We will talk about what we think each place is like and what we might see, hear etc.
